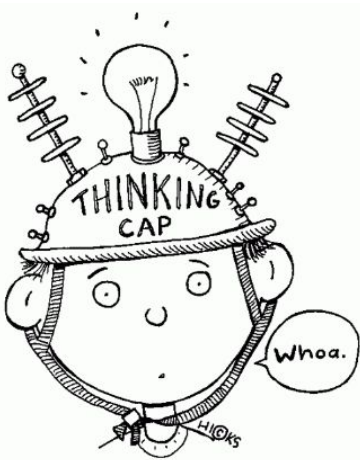
Liholiho Elementary is excited to announce and present:
