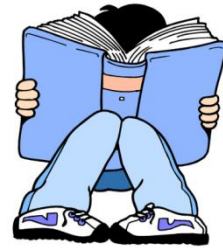


**Liholiho Laulima

READER'S KIT**



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**Here's what to do:**

Between Saturday, March 16, 2019 and Monday, March 25, 2019, find sponsors who will pledge a certain amount of money for every minute that you read. Add the sponsor's name and pledge to the pledge sheet.

- All reading counts, whether you are reading by yourself, reading to someone else, or having someone read to you. Read **as much** as you can.
- Small pledges are appreciated as much as large ones. Sponsors can indicate a maximum pledge.

**\*\*\* DO NOT go door-to-door or ask a stranger for a pledge \*\*\***

For 10 days, from Saturday, March 16, 2019 thru Monday, March 25, 2019, **READ, READ, READ!** Use the Reading Log to keep track of your minutes.

After March 25<sup>th</sup>, total your minutes and collect your pledges. Place the Pledge Sheet & donations in an envelope labeled with name & "PTA Read-a-Thon" and hand it into your teacher by **MONDAY, April 8<sup>th</sup>**.

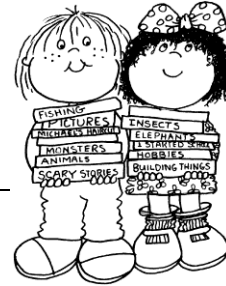
**INCENTIVES:**

As an EXTRA incentive, students who have the MOST MINUTES read or DOLLARS RAISED will be the recipients of the following awards:

- ★ The top 10 students with the **most minutes read** will have a yummy Pizza Lunch with Mrs. Small.
- ★ The student with the **most dollars raised** in each grade level will receive a goodie bag and be dubbed "Teacher of the Day" and help his/her teacher with class.

RULES**



The Read-A-Thon begins on Saturday, March 16, 2019.

Every minute you read counts! You will be reading for Liholiho Laulima, your PTA, who raises funds to provide services and resources that are not available through the State Government's approved budget. You may use the attached pledge sheet to keep track of your sponsors and how much they will donate.

**Reading that counts:**

1. Other people reading aloud to you, counts.
2. Reading aloud to other people, counts. If you read to your friend or your brother and sister, it counts for both of you!
3. Reading aloud to the cat, the dog, or the fish, counts.
4. Reading in a tree, on a bus, in a car, on a plane, in a hotel and under the bedcovers with a flashlight, counts.
5. Assigned reading for homework and book report reading, counts.
6. Reading comic books, newspapers, or magazines, counts.
7. Reading in another language, counts.

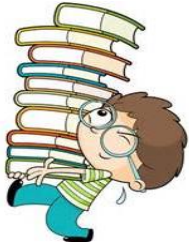
**Reading that does NOT count:**

1. Reading **before or after** the official Read-A-Thon period, does NOT count.
2. Reading the same book more than once, does NOT count.
3. Reading that you think you will do in the future if you have extra time, does NOT count.

**Important tips:**

- Use the clock, a timer, or a stopwatch to keep track of your reading time. No guessing or rounding off minutes.
- Keep your reading log handy at all times.
- **Do not go door to door to collect pledges and do not ask a stranger.** Your parents, grandparents, aunt, uncle, cousin, babysitter, doctor, dentist, family friends, are all good choices.

Make sure to bring your reading log, pledge sheet and donations collected, to your class in a sealed envelope **by MONDAY, April 8<sup>th</sup>**.

1. Donors may pledge an amount per minute or a flat rate donation. Donations are tax deductible.
